Registration Information

- The Registration Fee is \$150.00 due at time of registration. \$50.00 for each additional sibling.
- A Supply Fee of \$125.00 per child will be invoiced to our families in August.
- Both Registration Fee and Supply Fee will be pro-rated for rolling admissions if applicable.
- Registration form must be filled out, returned to the director, and fees paid to hold your child's spot.
- Enrollment will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis and is limited for each age group.
- Registration is open to children of families of all denominations.
- Our classrooms are a structured environment with a learning-through-play philosophy.
- Children with <u>developmental delays or special needs</u> are required to meet with the director before registration
 to discuss and ensure that we can safely provide for their child on a day-to-day basis. A trial period will be put in
 place to assess the child's adjustment to preschool as well as our ability to meet their needs in a positive
 progression. IEP meetings with your child's therapist may be required if we deem them necessary.
- Children must be <u>up-to-date on their vaccinations</u> following what is required by the NC Department of Health and Human Services. www.immunizenc.com.

A shot record from your doctor will be required before your child enters school

Classes Offered

All classes 9:00 am - 12:00 noon

Infant Classes

must be 6 months old by the $31^{\rm st}$ of August

Monday - Friday

*Parents may choose the days they would like their child to attend, but the availability of this class and/or days offered may change due to enrollment and the collective needs of parents

1-Year-Old Preschool Classes

must be 1 years old by the 31st of August 2-Day Tuesday / Thursday 3-Day Monday/ Wednesday / Friday 5-Day Monday - Friday

2-Year-Old Preschool Classes

must be 2 years old by the 31st of August 2-Day Tuesday / Thursday 3-Day Monday/ Wednesday / Friday 5-Day Monday - Friday

3-Year-Old Preschool Class

must be 3 years old by the 31st of August 2-Day Tuesday / Thursday 3-Day Monday/ Wednesday / Friday 5-Day Monday - Friday

4-Year-Old Pre-Kindergarten Class

must be 4 years old by the 31st of August & fully potty-trained **3-Day** Monday/ Wednesday / Friday **5-Day** Monday - Friday

Tuition

- 1-Day a week annual tuition will be \$990.00 (\$110.00 per month Sept-May)
- 2-Days a week annual tuition will be \$1,620.00 (\$180.00 per month Sept-May)
- 3-Days a week (M/W/F) annual tuition will be \$1,980.00 (\$220.00 per month Sept-May)
- 3-Days a week (T/W/Th) annual tuition will be \$2,160.00 (\$240.00 per month Sept-May)
- 4-Days a week annual tuition will be \$2,340.00 (\$260.00 per month Sept-May)
- 5-Days a week annual tuition will be \$2,880.00 (\$320.00 per month Sept-May)

Tuition will be invoiced at the beginning of each month.

If a child drops out, the full month's tuition is due.

10% LATE FEE will be charged to all delinquent accounts by the 16th of each month.

<u>Early Risers</u>

- Begins the second week of school
- Early Risers begins at 8:05am Monday through Friday. Cost is \$5.00 per day
 -No carpool option for Early Risers, families will bring their child into the preschool building
- Parents will be invoiced at the end of the month for any days your child attended.

Lunch Bunch will not be offered this year

<u>Arrival & Dismissal</u>

- **Carpool** will begin at <u>8:50 and continue until 9:00</u>. Any families arriving after 9:00 must enter the building through the church office doors to drop off their child
- Dismissal will begin at <u>11:50 and no later than 12:00</u>. Families will enter the preschool through the church office doors and exit through the back playground area

Medical Policy

- In order to minimize the spread of contagious germs, please keep your child home if they are running a fever, vomiting, or have diarrhea OR if anyone residing in your child's home is diagnosed with a contagious disease such as Flu, Covid, stomach bug, Strep, etc.
- We recognize that there are times when little ones may have runny noses due to allergies or teething, but if you suspect it may be something more than that, please err on the side of caution and keep them home.
- Children returning to school after being sick should be free from fever, diarrhea, vomiting, etc. for
 24 hours without the assistance of medication.

Emergency Conditions

- When the Craven County Schools are closed due to weather-related or emergency conditions, we will also be closed. In the event of a 2-hour delay, we will open at 10:30am and dismiss at 12:30pm.
- Information and alerts will be sent out through our ProCare parent app.
